RESCISSION

1. Purpose. This circular disseminates a rescission notice.
2. Applicability. This circular applies to all HQUSACE elements, major subordinate commands (MSC), districts, laboratories, and separate field operating activities (FOA) having civil works responsibilities and activities related to or affecting water control management.

5. Rescission. ER 1110-2-4001 "Notes on Sediment Activities" (reference 4.a) was established to prescribe general requirements for submittal of annual reports on Corps of Engineers activities in the field of sedimentation. The annual reports were intended to serve as the Corps of Engineers contribution of information to the Subcommittee on Sedimentation, Interagency Advisory Committee on Water Data, for use in preparation of its annual publication titled "Notes on Sedimentation Activities." This report is no longer published on an annual basis with last report published in 1992. Therefore, ER 1110-2-4001 is obsolete and hereby rescinded. Reporting requirements for sedimentation activities are addressed in ER 1110-2-8153, Sedimentation Investigations.
